From 1968-1969, he was assistant to renowned mathematician, Marston Morse, at the Institute for Advanced Study in Princeton, NJ. He translated three volumes of classical mathematics texts by Leonard Euler from Latin into English.

John, a daily communicant, was a longtime parishioner of Church of the Transfiguration. After he retired, he volunteered at St. Joseph's House of Hospitality.
